We are significantly increasing our cleaning frequency of high-traffic areas and high-touch items, including the lounge bar, doorknobs, banisters, tabletops, and handrails. Post 28 Officers are 100 percent dedicated to keeping the Post a healthy and safe environment. Your help is important too.

- **Please be sure to keep your hands washed using soap**
- **Use Hand Sanitizer**
- **Avoid touching your eyes, nose, or mouth with unwashed hands**
- **Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when coughing or sneezing**
- **Avoid handshakes**
- **Avoid contact with sick people who are sick; and**
- **Stay home when you are sick**

The health and well-being of you and our guests is our highest priority and will continue to closely monitor information and guidance from public health officials as the situation develops.
